## 1. Purpose

AGEFA GmbH supports the responsible sourcing of tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3TG). The purpose of this policy is to help ensure that products supplied by AGEFA do not knowingly contain minerals that finance armed conflict or contribute to serious human rights abuses.

## 2. Scope

This policy applies to AGEFA GmbH and to products in our supply portfolio that may contain 3TG. AGEFA is a distributor and does not purchase minerals directly from mines, smelters or refiners. We therefore rely on information provided by manufacturers and relevant upstream suppliers.

## 3. Our principles

- We do not knowingly source products containing 3TG that contribute to armed conflict or serious human rights abuses.
- We support supply-chain due diligence in line with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas.
- We expect relevant manufacturers and suppliers to source minerals responsibly and to provide accurate and current supply-chain information.
- We request Conflict Minerals Reporting Templates (CMRTs) or equivalent declarations where this is relevant to the products supplied.
- We review the information received and follow up where information is missing, incomplete or inconsistent.
- Where a material risk is identified, we will work with the supplier on appropriate corrective action and, where necessary, consider alternative sources.

## 4. Implementation and documentation

The Managing Director is responsible for this policy. Relevant supplier declarations and CMRTs are retained as supporting records. The policy and available supply-chain information are reviewed periodically and updated when necessary. This policy is available to customers and other interested parties upon request.
